Practical Information

1. Venue: Imperial Golf View Hotel

The venue is a walkable distance from the Entebbe Golf Course and Lake Victoria, five minutes' drive from the Entebbe International Airport, the hotel offers breath-taking panoramic views of the Great Lake Victoria and the Entebbe Golf course.

2. About Uganda



The Capital City of Uganda is Kampala.

Home to the source of the world's longest river (river Nile), the world's remaining Mountain Gorillas, vast and diverse natural wildlife reserves; blessed with tropical, all year-round summer weather, a diverse cultural heritage of over 50 local tribes, snow caped mountains, natural water rafting spots, a vibrant night life. A wealth of unexploited natural resources and a young, educated population.

English is the official language in Uganda. The current population is 48 million.

3. Visa Information

Nationals from the East African Community (EAC), COMESA and Commonwealth are exempt from visa into Uganda.

a) Requirements

- ✓ Passport copy (bio-data page) with at least 6 months validity.
- ✓ Letter of invitation with clear address (host country will provide this through the coordinators)
- ✓ Recent Passport-size photograph taken in the last 6 months.
- ✓ Vaccination certificate (Yellow Fever)
- ✓ Visa fees \$50.

Please note that the entire visa application process is online, once your visa is approved, download the approval letter **(travel authorization/visa approval letter)** and you can either go to the Ugandan Embassy in your country to have it personalized or you can travel and have it personalized at the point of entry at the Entebbe International Airport. You are encouraged to submit your e-visa applications 30 days in advance to allow for any delays or eventualities.

4. Health and Vaccinations

All visitors require vaccination against yellow fever and will be required to present the vaccination card on arrival at the airport.

Please note that travellers entering Uganda no longer need to present a Covid-19 Vaccine certificate or a PCR test.

Anti-malaria tablets are recommended. Visit your local travel clinic to determine which type is best for you. Even if you are taking anti-malarials, you should still wear insect repellent. Most hotels will have mosquito nets so be sure to use them. Bring all prescription medications with you as they may not be readily available in Uganda. Be sure to purchase travel insurance before you begin your trip. All visitors require vaccination against yellow fever and will be required to present the vaccination card on arrival at the airport.

5. Money

1 USD = 3721 UGX

Uganda is a cash-based economy where the Uganda Shilling is the mode of transaction. You can easily buy it at the point of entry and at forex bureaus around the venue area in Bugolobi. Major international credit/debit cards are widely accepted as well as Mobile Money Transfers for nationals of the East African Region.
